



## Oxford Fair Woodsmen Events General Rules

### Showtime: Friday 10:00am

Check in and pick up numbers, heat sheets and T-shirts on show day **starting at 8:00 AM and ending at 9:30 AM.**  
**Blocks and numbers will be drawn at registration.**

- 1) The decision of the judge will be final. The judge may disqualify any contestant for any major failure to comply with official directions.
- 2) Contestants are responsible for verifying the time with timers after each heat.
- 3) Contestants must furnish their own tools.
- 4) In the event of adverse weather conditions, some or all events may be eliminated, or rules altered at the discretion of the judge.
- 5) Unsportsmanlike conduct or alcohol and/or drug abuse will result in disqualification of any or all events.
- 6) In sawing events if the wood breaks and the judge can put the pieces together and make a full piece, the time will be allowed, and the contestant not disqualified.
- 7) Runoffs for 1<sup>st</sup> place ties **ONLY**. For other ties, money will be pooled and split between involved contestants; this does not apply to axe throw.
- 8) Only the head judge will approve of wood changes.
- 9) Children are **NOT** permitted in designated competition areas during contests.
- 10) **NO** dogs are allowed on the grounds.
- 11) Contestants must be 18 years old. Masters must be 55 years old at the time of the event.
- 12) All results are final at the end of the show.
- 13) Only official time sheets will be used. **NO VIDEOS, PICTURES, Etc. WILL BE CONSIDERED**
- 14) Three championships:  
MEN'S CHAMPION\*\*\*\*MASTER'S CHAMPION\*\*\*\*WOMEN'S CHAMPION  
Winner of each receives \$250. There will be **NO** qualifying events for the Championships this year. The winner of Each division will be determined by the number of points earned for each event entered, except tree felling.

#### **POINT SYSTEM FOR CHAMPIONSHIP:**

**1<sup>st</sup> place:** 5 points    **2<sup>nd</sup> place:** 4 points    **3<sup>rd</sup> place:** 3 points    **4<sup>th</sup> place:** 2 points    **5<sup>th</sup> place:** 1 point

In the event of a tie, the contestant with the highest place finishes will determine the winner. If this does not determine a champion, a three throw - Axe Throw will be utilized to determine the winner.

#### **PREMIUMS:**

**1<sup>st</sup>:** \$85    **2<sup>nd</sup>:** \$60    **3<sup>rd</sup>:** \$55    **4<sup>th</sup>:** \$40    **5<sup>th</sup>:** \$35

(Both contestants in double classes will each be awarded the premiums).

\*\*\*Registration must be completed through the mail.\*\*\*

**Contestant fee: \$20.00—due with registration (check payable to Oxford Fair)**

Non-contestants will be charged at the gate, children under age 5 are free.



Please enter the grounds at the **Main Gate** (1st gate on Pottle Road). The event will be held at the same location.
